CHAPTER 1

FROM DECISION TO DIRECTION

SS-003 gave you a framework for deciding well. This module asks a different, larger question underneath every individual decision: what has the Father actually entrusted you to do with your life? Not just this choice, but the overall direction your gifts, opportunities, and responsibilities point toward.

This is where stewardship (SS-001) and identity (SS-002) become specific rather than general. It is one thing to know you are a steward, entrusted and beloved. It is another to know, concretely, what you personally have been entrusted with.



CHAPTER 2

GIFTS ARE NOT ACCIDENTS

Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of the Father's grace in its various forms.

1 Peter 4:10

Notice the word this verse uses: stewards. Your gifts — the specific abilities, inclinations, and capacities you have — are not accidents of personality. They are part of what SS-001 already established you're entrusted with. A gift is not primarily something you own or something to be proud of. It is something to steward on behalf of others.

IN PLAIN LANGUAGE

This reframes a common question. Instead of "what am I good at?" the more useful question is "what have I been entrusted with, and who is it meant to serve?"



CHAPTER 3

CALLING IS BIGGER THAN CAREER

Calling and career are often treated as the same thing. They aren't. A career is what you do for income, in a given season. A calling is the broader direction your life is pointed — it can express itself through multiple careers, seasons, and roles over a lifetime, and it doesn't disappear when a job changes.

Career	Calling
A specific job or profession	A lifelong direction and set of entrusted gifts
Can change several times	Remains consistent across changes
Measured by income or title	Measured by faithfulness to what's entrusted
A means of provision	A means of stewardship, which may include provision

IN PLAIN LANGUAGE

A career change is not automatically a calling crisis. Sometimes it's simply the same calling finding a new expression.



CHAPTER 4

DISCOVERING WHAT'S BEEN ENTRUSTED

A few honest questions, worth returning to periodically:

- What do people consistently come to you for help with, without you advertising it?
- What work leaves you more energized afterward, rather than only depleted?
- What needs do you notice that others seem to walk past?
- What have you already been faithfully doing, even in small or unpaid ways?
- What resources, relationships, or opportunities are currently in your hands, whether or not they feel significant?

Notice what this list does not include: a demand for certainty, or a single dramatic revelation. Calling is often discovered gradually, through faithfulness in what's already in front of you, more often than through a singular moment of clarity.



CHAPTER 5

PURPOSE IS LIVED, NOT JUST FOUND

SS-001 established this principle already, applied here directly: purpose is not merely discovered — it is lived out through faithfully embracing the responsibilities the Father entrusts to us. The same is true of calling specifically. You will not think your way into certainty about your purpose. You will live your way into clarity, by faithfully stewarding what's already in your hands.

This does not mean discernment doesn't matter — SS-003's framework still applies here. It means discernment and action work together, not discernment first and action only after total certainty arrives. Certainty often follows faithfulness, not the reverse.



CHAPTER 6

A CALLING INVENTORY

A brief, honest inventory. Return to it as your circumstances change.

KLF PRINCIPLES

FAITHFULNESS BEFORE CERTAINTY

- Your gifts are entrusted to you to serve others, not merely to be admired or monetized.
- Calling is bigger than career, and a career change is not automatically a calling crisis.
- Calling is discovered gradually through faithfulness, more often than through a single dramatic revelation.
- Certainty often follows faithful action. It rarely arrives before it.
- The question is not only "what am I good at," but "what have I been entrusted with, and who is it meant to serve?"



APPENDIX

GLOSSARY

Term	Definition
Calling	The specific purpose and responsibility the Father entrusts to an individual, broader and more durable than a career.
Gift	An ability or capacity entrusted to a person, meant to be stewarded in service of others rather than owned for personal credit.
Career	A specific job or profession, which may express a calling but is not identical to it.
