CHAPTER 1

FROM LEADERSHIP TO LEGACY

SS-006 established that influence is entrusted, not owned, and that Kingdom greatness is measured by how faithfully that influence serves others — while you're present to exercise it. This module asks a harder question: what remains of that stewardship after you're no longer the one leading?

Legacy is not a separate concern from everything this library has already covered. It's the same stewardship question — SS-001's central question — extended past your own lifetime: what are you doing, right now, with what the Father has entrusted to you, that will still matter after you're gone?

IN PLAIN LANGUAGE

Legacy isn't a topic reserved for the end of life. It's what today's faithfulness is quietly building toward, whether or not you're thinking about it that way.



CHAPTER 2

WHAT LEGACY ACTUALLY MEANS

We will not hide these things from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, His power, and the wonders He has done.

Psalm 78:4

Notice what this verse identifies as the inheritance worth passing on: not primarily possessions, but a testimony — what the Father has done, and how He is faithful. Legacy, in its fullest biblical sense, is the transmission of faith, character, and truth from one generation to the next, not merely the transmission of assets.

This doesn't make material inheritance unimportant — Scripture addresses that too, and directly. It means material inheritance was never meant to be the whole of it, or even the primary part.



CHAPTER 3

DISCIPLESHIP: THE MULTIPLYING LEGACY

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

2 Timothy 2:2

This verse describes a chain: Paul to Timothy, Timothy to reliable people, those people to others still. That's four generations of transmission in a single sentence — and it's the clearest biblical pattern for what a spiritual legacy actually looks like in practice.

Discipleship — intentionally passing on what you've learned to someone else, who then does the same — multiplies in a way that a one-time inheritance cannot. Money divided among heirs gets smaller with each generation. Faith and character, faithfully disciplined, can multiply instead.

IN PLAIN LANGUAGE

The question isn't only "what will I leave them," but "who am I intentionally investing in, right now, the way Paul invested in Timothy?"



CHAPTER 4

THE BOUNDARY WITH FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

Legacy and inheritance are also addressed in FS-008: Building Generational Wealth, in the Financial Stewardship Library. That's not a duplication — the two modules address the same word from different, complementary angles.

CHAPTER 5

LEGACY IS BUILT NOW, NOT JUST PLANNED LATER

SS-005 established that faithfulness is proven in small, ordinary moments — not primarily in dramatic ones. The same principle applies directly here: legacy is not a document you write at the end of life. It is the accumulated pattern of everything you've faithfully done, disciplined, and passed on along the way.

A conversation where you explain why you gave generously. A moment where a child or mentee watches how you handled a setback with integrity. A habit of prayer someone quietly noticed and later adopted themselves. None of these feel like "building a legacy" in the moment. All of them are exactly that.



CHAPTER 6

A LEGACY REFLECTION

A brief, honest reflection. Return to it as your relationships and seasons change.

Who am I currently, intentionally discipling — investing in the way Paul invested in Timothy?

What testimony of the Father's faithfulness in my own life am I actively passing on, and to whom?

If someone only watched my ordinary, unremarkable days, what would they learn about what I actually value?

One specific way I can invest in someone else's faith or character this month:



KLF PRINCIPLES

LEGACY MULTIPLIES, INHERITANCE DIVIDES

- Legacy is the transmission of faith, character, and truth — not primarily the transmission of possessions.
- Discipleship multiplies. A one-time inheritance divides. Both matter; they are not the same thing.
- Legacy is built in ordinary, unremarkable days, not written as a single document at the end of life.
- SS-007 and FS-008 are complementary, not duplicate — the spiritual purpose and the financial mechanics of the same word.
- The question isn't only what you'll leave behind. It's who you're intentionally investing in right now.



APPENDIX

GLOSSARY

Term	Definition
Legacy	What is intentionally passed from one generation to the next — faith, character, and testimony, alongside any material inheritance.
Discipleship	Intentionally investing in another person's faith and character so they, in turn, can invest in others.
Inheritance	What is entrusted to the next generation; addressed here in its spiritual sense and in FS-008 in its financial sense.
Testimony	The account of the Father's faithfulness in one's own life, offered as evidence and encouragement to others.
